## **Tournament regulations**

### **Registration**

Registration is open on [vipcup.lt](http://vipcup.lt) or by email [zperminas@gmail.com](mailto:zperminas@gmail.com) after the publication of tournament regulations.

Participants must specify their name, surname and squads preferred in the registration.

Participants can be registered for a maximum of three unplayed squads.

## **Bonus points**

- LBF members – given by the organisers, taking into account each player's average during the seasons of years 2023-2025 (LBC, LBL, VIP Cup), as well as the level of skills of the player.
- Non-LBF members – Men +16; Women, Juniors, Seniors +20.
- Non-LBF members, who have participated in the VIP Cup multiple times – bonus points are awarded by the decision of the organizers, after evaluating statistics of the previous tournaments.

The specified prize fund is set if there are at least 70 registered participants before the start of the tournament. In case the number of registered participants is less than 70, the prize fund is reduced.

## **Doubles**

Doubles can be registered until the end of the current squad warm-up. Doubles can only be made of two players playing in the same squad. In one squad, a single player can form a double with different players, i.e. a player can participate in two or more doubles in the same squad. Players cannot form a double, if both athletes have 0 (zero) Hcp.

The scores of the participants are added together with the players' Hcp. Doubles winners and prize winners are determined based on the sum of 10 games.

The doubles prize fund is determined by the percentage of collected doubles entry fees, as shown in the table above. Both participants of the winning pair are awarded a trophy.

## **Tournament format**

### **1. QUALIFICATION**

*August 21 – 24 (Thursday – Friday – Saturday - Sunday)*

Each participant plays 5 games. Based on the sum of the 5 games, 28 athletes qualify for the next round.

## 2. **FINAL STAGE**

### **Stage I (28 players) - August 24 (Sunday) 12:30**

Each participant plays 4 games. The result of the Final stage I is added to the result of the Qualification. Based on the total sum of 9 games, 20 athletes qualify for the Final stage II – 1-4th places go directly to the 3rd step of the Final stage II, while 5-20th places go to the 1st step of the Final stage II.

### **Stage II (20 players) - August 24 (Sunday) 14:30**

#### **1st step.**

Results of the Qualification and the Final stage I are cancelled.

Four groups of four players each are formed based on the place taken after the Final stage I:

A – 5; 12; 13; 20 - (Lanes 17-18)

B – 6; 11; 14; 19 - (Lanes 19-20)

C – 7; 10; 15; 18 - (Lanes 21-22)

D – 8; 9; 16; 17 - (Lanes 23-24)

Two games are played. Based on the sum of the two games, the top two from each group, a total of eight players, qualify for the 2nd step.

#### **2nd step.**

All previous results are cancelled.

Two groups of four players each are formed:

E – A + D (1 step) - (Lanes 21-22)

F – B + C (1 step) - (Lanes 23-24)

Two games are played. Based on the sum of the two games, the top two from each group, a total of four players, qualify for the 3rd step.

#### **3rd step.**

Places 1-4th of the Final stage I join in.

All previous results are cancelled.

Two groups of four players each are formed:

G – 1 + 4 + F - (Lanes 17-18)

H – 2 + 3 + E - (Lanes 19-20)

Two games are played. Based on the sum of the two games, the top two from each group, a total of four players, qualify for the semifinals.

### **Semifinals, Final (4 players) - August 24 (Sunday) 17:30**

One game is played in the semifinals. Winners qualify for the final.

1 pair – G group 1st place versus H group 2nd place - (Lane 18)

2 pair – G group 2nd place versus H group 1st place - (Lane 20)

One game is played in the finals - (Lane 19)

## **Additional information**

- Lanes are prepared before each qualification squad, before the 1st step of the final stage and the semi-finals.
- The final places of the losing players in the final round are assigned based on the result achieved in the Final stage I.
- In case of a tie (equal result) in the qualification, in the Final stages I and II - the last game of the current stage, the penultimate one, etc. is considered, including Hcp.
- In case of a tie in the semi-final or final, roll-offs are played.

**Depending on the number of participants in the tournament, the organizers reserve the right to change the tournament schedule, regulations and prize fund, notifying the tournament participants beforehand.**
